Environmental precautions Methods for cleaning up

Carbon dioxide. Dry powder. Water spray jet. Fight larger fires with water spray jet or alcohol-resistant

Dilute with plenty of water. Do not allow to enter drainage system, surface or ground water. Dyke to collect large liquid spills. Absorb with liquid-binding material (sand, diatomite, universal binders).

Do not place spilled materials back into the original container. Collect in closed and suitable containers

for disposal.
